### Dental Health

-Tooth decay (dental caries) affects children in the United States more than any other chronic infectious disease.

-Untreated tooth decay causes pain and infections that may lead to problems; such as eating, speaking, playing, and learning.

-An estimated 51 million school hours per year are lost because of dental-related illness.

-Students ages 5 to 17 years missed 1,611,000 school days in 1996 due to acute dental problems—an average of 3.1 days per 100 students.
